

# Homeowner Contractor Scorecard (One-Pager)

Use for Modernize-matched contractors. Score each line 1–5 (1=poor/unclear, 5=excellent). Red flags override totals.

Fit & Trust	Project fit (similar jobs; understands goals)		
Fit & Trust	Professionalism (prepared, respectful, straightforward)		
Fit & Trust	Communication quality (clear answers; explains tradeoffs)		
Fit & Trust	Responsiveness (follows through; timely replies)		
Fit & Trust	References (current/recent; feedback checks out)		
Fit & Trust	License/insurance proof (prompt; matches contract name)		
Quote Clarity	Scope detail (specific inclusions; not vague)		
Quote Clarity	Exclusions explicit (clearly states what's not included)		
Quote Clarity	Allowances realistic (listed with \$ and what they cover)		
Quote Clarity	Materials plan clear (who buys what; lead times)		
Quote Clarity	Cleanup/protection included (floors; debris; daily standard)		
Quote Clarity	Change order process (written; priced; approved before work)		
Quote Clarity	Warranty/callback terms (clear coverage and duration)		
Schedule & Plan	Start window realism (aligns with workload)		
Schedule & Plan	Timeline clarity (duration + key milestones)		
Schedule & Plan	Supervision (named lead; job load)		
Schedule & Plan	Permits/inspections plan (who pulls/pays; coordination)		
Schedule & Plan	Risk plan (hidden issues; pricing approach)		
Price & Payment	Payment schedule quality (milestones; reasonable deposit)		
Price & Payment	Price makes sense (consistent with scope; not underbid)		

## Red Flags (any YES = pause and reassess):

Refuses/avoids providing license or insurance documentation  Says permits aren't needed when they likely are  
 Quote is vague (lots of "TBD") with no clear process to finalize  Poor communication before the job starts  
 Pushes large upfront payment before meaningful work begins  Wants to proceed on verbal change orders
